DETAILS OF WORK

Set approximately 160' of 10-3/4" 32.75# 11-40 casing and circulate cement.

Set approximately 3450' of 7-5/8" 26.40# J55 casing and cement with approximately 200 sts with 4% gal cement.

Set approximately 5000' of 5-1/2" 15.90# J-35 casing and cement with approximately 125 sts 4% gal cement.

Drill to a TD of 5500' and sandfrac with approximately 20,000 gal of diesel fuel to test the Huerfano formation.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
