CONCLUSIONS

1. *Chlorophyll a* and *Chlorophyll b* were determined by the method of Arar and Collins (1971).

2. **Effect of the number of trials.** The number of trials was varied from 10 to 100. The results are shown in Figure 2. The number of trials had a significant effect on the error rate ($F(9, 18) = 10.12, p < 0.001$). The error rate decreased as the number of trials increased. The error rate was significantly lower for 100 trials than for 10 trials ($F(1, 18) = 10.12, p < 0.01$).
