

DETAILS OF WORK

It was originally intended to complete this well in the Pictured Cliffs formation, but results of stimulative treatment show the Pictured Cliffs to be non-commercial. It is, therefore, planned to set a cast iron cement retainer above the existing Pictured Cliffs perforations at 4272-4526' and squeeze off said perforations with 100 sacks cement. The Fruitland formation will then be perforated and fractured with water and sand. Should the Fruitland formation prove to be commercial, the well will be completed as a Fruitland gas well with the SE/4 of Section 9 dedicated to the Fruitland formation.
