El Paso Natural Gas Company is the operator of the No. 2 San Juan 30-6 Unit well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 9, T. 30 N., R. 6 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease New Mexico 03384. Said well was completed April 25, 1953, and has never been produced commercially. Your Sundry Notice, dated November 17, 1971, indicated an investigation for a casing leak was to be made. No report of such an investigation has been received.

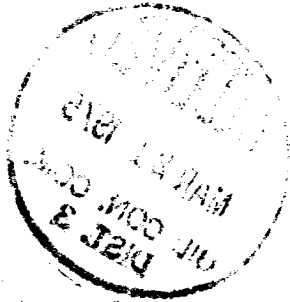
Temporary abandonment of any well under jurisdiction of the U.S. Geological Survey must now receive formal approval. Such approval may be granted, for a period not to exceed one year, provided reasons for temporary abandonment are deemed adequate.

Please submit an original and four copies of Sundry Notice (form 9-331) requesting temporary abandonment for the above well. This request should set forth the present status, date of last production, reason for requesting temporary abandonment, and future plans for the well including approximate dates of planned workovers or plugging operations.
