Instructions

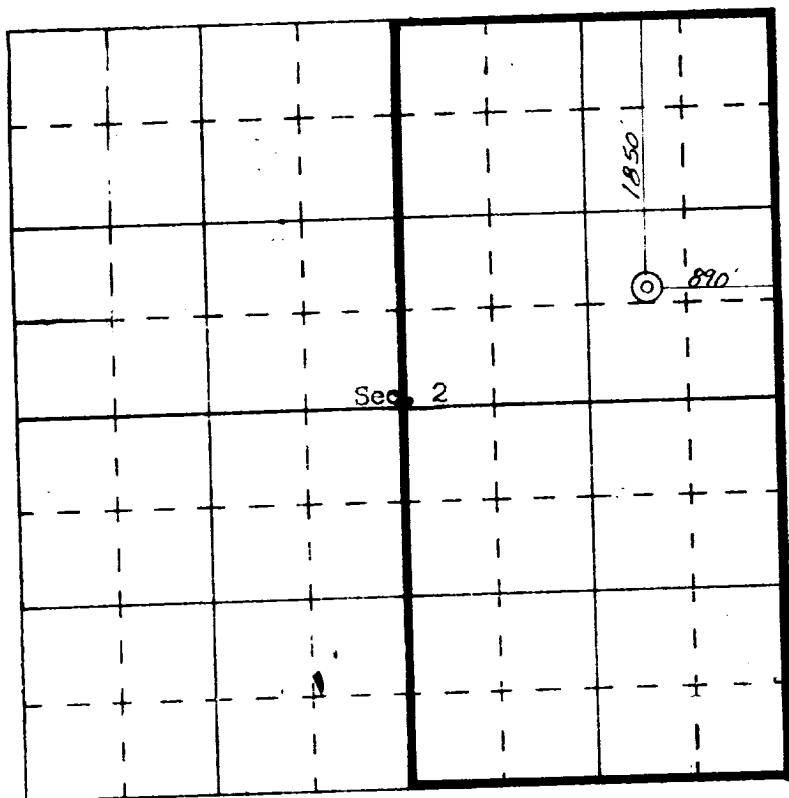
