Dear Mr. Busch:

Meridian Oil Inc., as agent for El Paso Natural Gas Company, is requesting approval of the Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas (C-104) for the San Juan 30-6 Unit #412 Fruitland Coal well without actual shut in surface or bottom hole pressures in this wellbore. Approval is requested due to our concern about shutting in this well to obtain pressure surveys because of the high likelihood of mechanical problems which could jeopardize this wellbore.

After production has stabilized and a performance history of the well has been established, Meridian will be happy to obtain actual pressures if they are desired. As we also discussed, we are supplying you with pressure data from the nearest wells to the #412, and have utilized an average pressure from these wells for our filing. Attached is the data from these wells and a map showing their location in relation to the San Juan 30-6 Unit #412.

Your assistance is greatly appreciated, and prompt approval is requested. If you have any questions or require additional information, please let me know.
