Meridian Oil Gathering Inc. hereby requests permission to lay a temporary, above-ground gas flow line on BLM lands within an archaeologically surveyed area and substantially within an existing MOGI H2O pipeline right-of-way (NM-76762) from the MOI San Juan 30-6 #481 approximately 4250 feet to the MOI San Juan 30-6 #417 (see attached survey plats and topo map). APPROVAL OF THIS SUNDRY SHOULD PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINGENCY INSTALLATION OF A SECOND LINE SHOULD FLOW RATES WARRANT. This line would be used to flow gas from a portion of the 30-6 system presently slated to be turned off during construction of the Frances Mesa Suction/Discharge system.

Meridian would complete construction of this temporary line by June 1, 1995 to coincide with construction of the Frances Mesa Projects, and would expect to remove the line by the end of September, 1995.

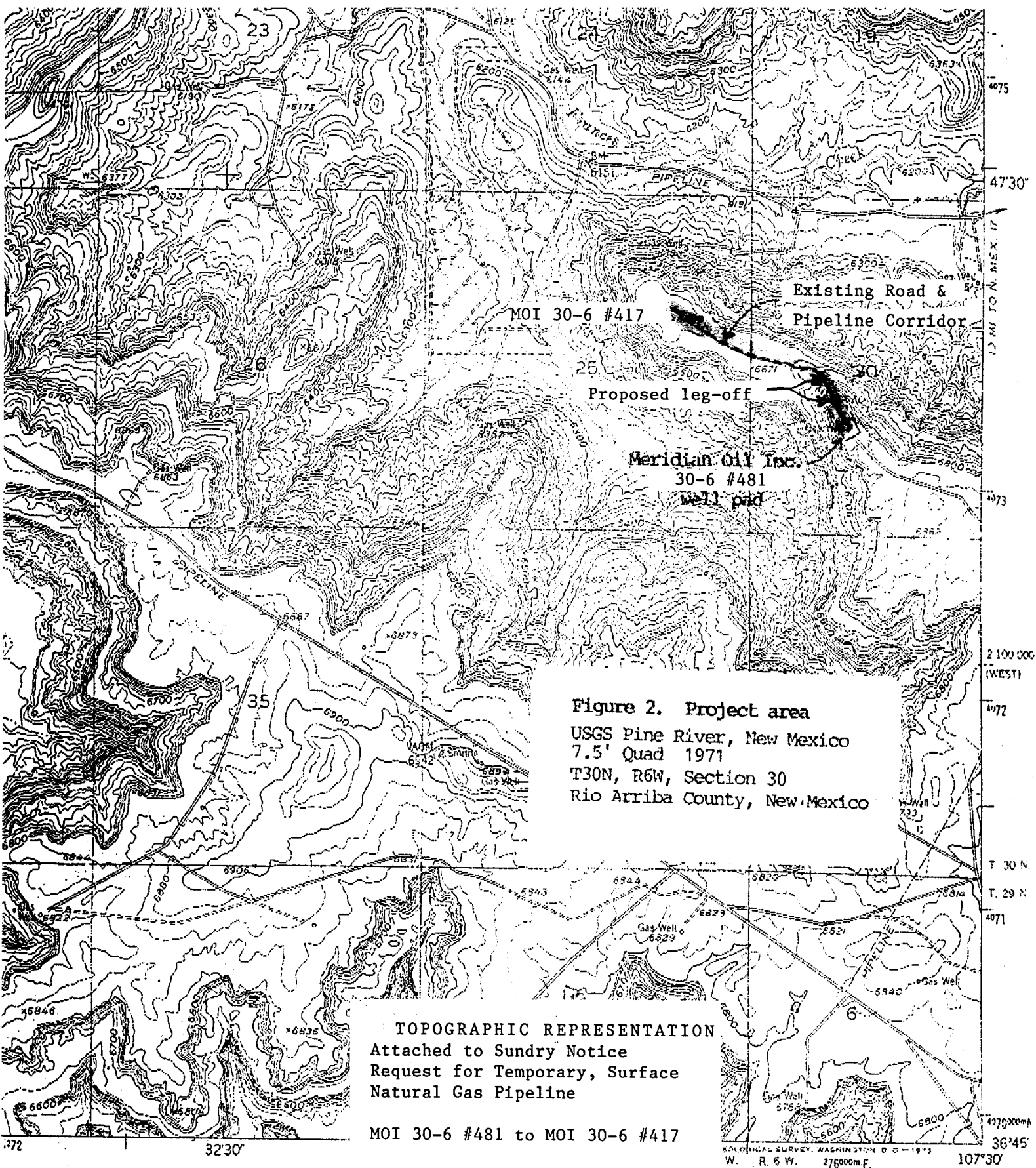
