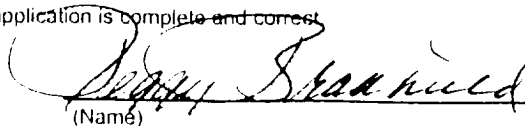

Expected Production before Workover

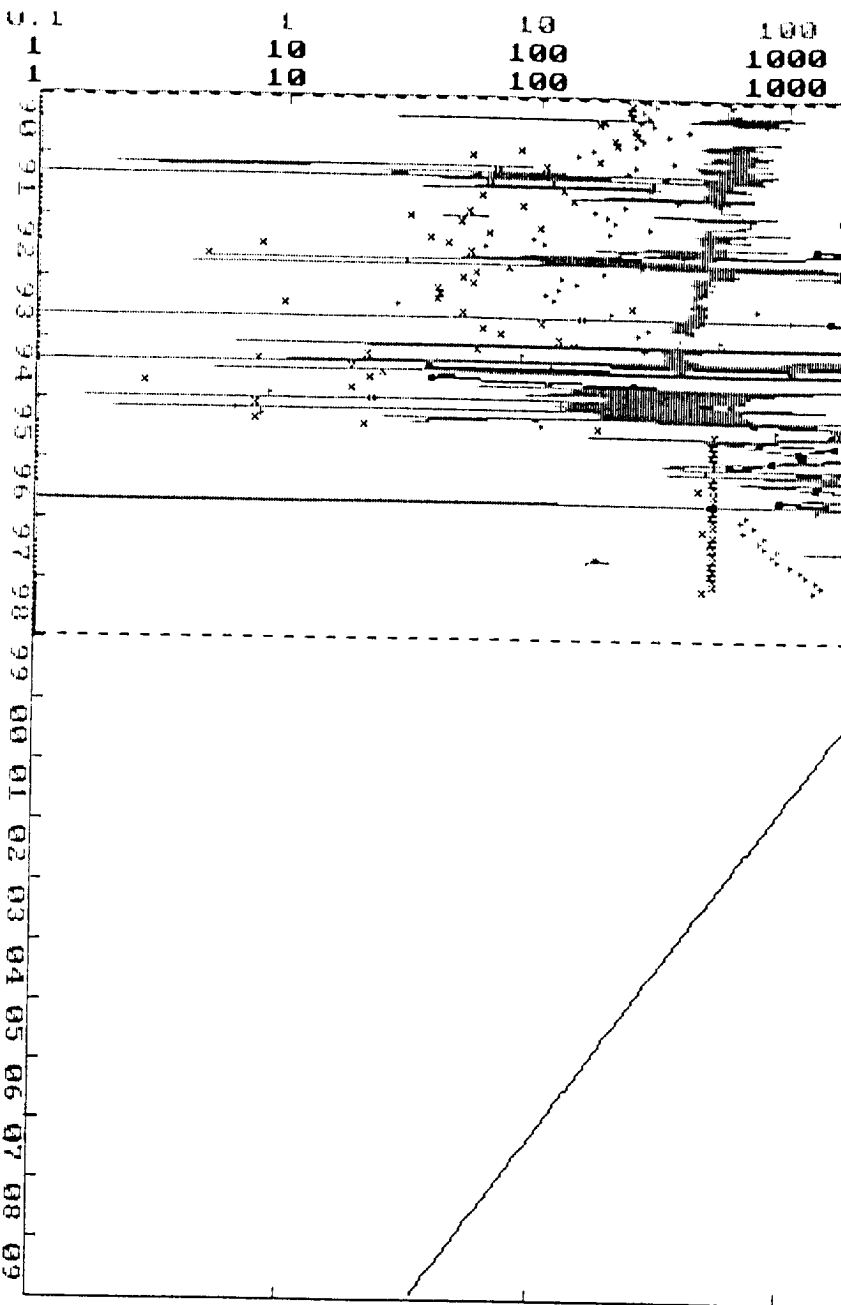
