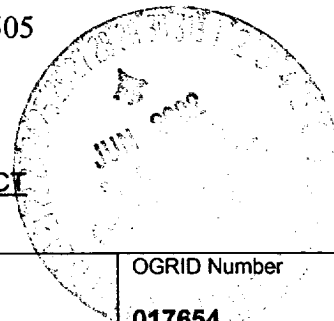

Description of workover procedure used to increase production of the subject well:

A pumping unit was installed and the work entailed:

1. Setting a concrete pad.
2. Place the pumping unit on top of the pad.
3. Run fuel gas lines or electrical power to run the engine.
4. MIRU.
5. Pulls the tubing.
6. RIH w/bottomhole assemble.
7. Run RTP (rods, tubing and pump).
8. RD rig and MO.
9. Hook up and return well to production.

Work began approx. 11/5/2001 and was completed 11/8/2001.
