Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated December 9, 1994 for an unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location for your existing San Juan 30-6 Unit Well No. 66-R (API No. 30-039-25400), which was drilled in June, 1994 and completed in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool at an unorthodox gas well location (approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-3384, dated April 28, 1994) 255 feet from the South line and 190 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that Meridian intends to dually complete said well in both the Pictured Cliffs formation and Blanco-Mesaverde Pool; and, pursuant to Division General Rule 104.B(2)(a) said well location is considered to be unorthodox for Pictured Cliffs gas production.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(1), the abovedescribed unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location is hereby approved.

Further, all provisions of said original Order NSL-3384 shall remain in full force and affect until further notice.



Reference is made to your application dated March 14, 1994 for an unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde gas well location on an existing 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Said GPU presently has dedicated thereon the San Juan 30-6 Unit Well Nos. 66 and 66-A located in Units "K" and "F", respectively, of said Section 14.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

San Juan 30-6 Unit Well No. 66-R 255' FSL - 190' FWL (Unit M)

Further, Meridian is authorized to simultaneously dedicate Blanco-Mesaverde gas production on the subject GPU from the No. 66-R well with the two existing Well Nos. 66 and 66-A. Said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico.
