NORTHWEST NEWMEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. A packer lankage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the cree authorizing the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and or chemical or fracture treatment, and wherever remedial work has been cone on a well during which the packer or the tubing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when requested by the Division.
- 2. At least 72 years prior to the commentement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so notified.
- 3. The packer easage test shall commence when both zones of the dual completion are shiften for pressure stabilization. Both yones shall remain shut-in until the well-head pressure in each has stabilized provided however, that they need not remain shut-in more than see or days.
- For Flow Test No one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal fatter of product in while the order zone remains shadin. Such test shall be continued for several days in the case of a gas well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Note it, on an initial packet reasage test in gas well is being flowed to the atmosphere due to lick of a pipeline connection the flow per od-shall be three flows.
- 5 . Folk wing completion of Faw Test No. 1, the web shall again be shut-in, in accordance to an Puragraph 3 above.

Pressures for gas-zone tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours tests immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at fifteen-mirrute intervals during the first nour thereof, and at his any intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the contrask of each flow period. T-day tests immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, or least one time during each flow period, an approximately the midway points and in recontexprior to the conclusion of each flow period. If a well is a gas-oil or an outgas data, completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with readweight pressures as required above being taken on the gas zone.
