13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

A meeting was held 2-8-99 including Steve Mason, Chip Harridan of the BLM and Ken Collins, Peggy Bradfield of Burlington Resources.

After further analysis of the CBLs run on the subject well, it was noted that there was isolation further up hole than was previously reported. Although final cement top after squeezes was picked at approximately 2360', there were up-hole cement stringers that were not reported as the final CBL was not run above 2100'. There was weak cement bond across the following intervals at varying degrees of integrity: 340-365', 430-525', 665-725', 970-1085', 1160-1825'. There was a very strong isolating bond indicated at 1070-1082'.

The bradenhead of the subject well will be monitored for any water flows.

Approval was granted by Steve Mason and Chip Harridan to leave well as it is at this time.
