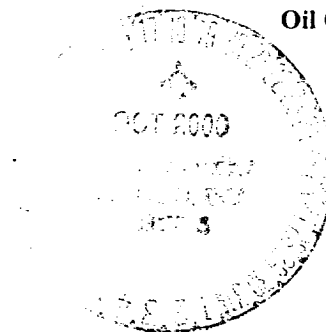

Dear Ms. Cole:

Reference is made to your application submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on September 13, 2000 for a non-standard 218.36-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool:

**RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM
Irregular Section 24: Lots 1 through 4 and the W/2 E/2 (E/2 equivalent).**

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company's proposed San Juan "30-5" Unit Well No. 267 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 2125 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 24.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved.
