We intend to complete this well in the Dakota formation at an approximate depth of 6325 feet.

If logs indicate commercial production, 5 1/2" csg will be run through the Dakota, cemented w/250 sax, 50/50 Poz, and second staged at 1900' w/80 sax 50/50 Poz. The casing will be perforated and sand-water fraced in the Dakota formation.

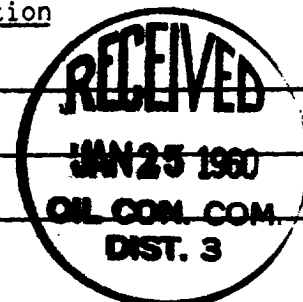

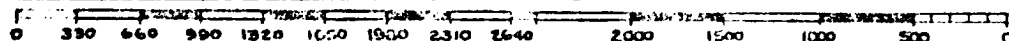
