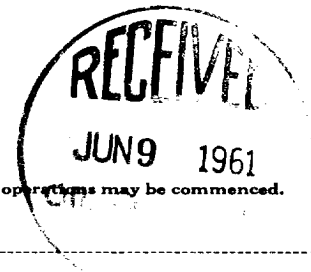

DETAILS OF WORK

Slotted 4-1/2" casing with Triple Free Hatch outer at 5664'. Frased well with 31,500 gallons oil containing 5 pounds FR-1 and 50 pounds Adomite Mark II per 1000 gallons and 21,000 pounds sand. Breakdown pressure 3300 psi, maximum treating pressure 3300 psi, minimum treating pressure 2900 psi, average injection rate 28.5 barrels per minute. 2" tubing landed at 5754'.

Completed June 2, 1961 as flowing oil well Totah Gallup Field. Potential test 244 barrels of oil per day.
