WE PROPOSE TO:

1. Move in suitable unit, pull tubing and run Corrosion log on 5-1/2" casing and repair casing as required.
2. Clean out to T.D. of 1941 ft. R.K.B.
3. Sand-Water Frac open hole from 1845 to 1941 and perms from 1818 to 1830 with single stage frac job of approx. 50,000# sand and 50,000 gallons water.
4. Run 1-1/2" tbg. and place well on production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
