
THE APPLICATION OF ASTEC OIL 6 GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.



ADMINISTRATIVE CROSS OF THE OIL CONSERVATION CONSISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Astec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on Pebruary 22, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Cain Well No. 15 located in Unit H of Section 11, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, MMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Messwerde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

How, on this 13th day of March, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE CROSSED:

That the applicant herein, Astec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Cain Well No. 15 located in Unit N of Section 31, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, MIPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

## IT IS FURTHER CADERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
