DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of the above well ceasing to produce gas in commercial quantities, we plugged and abandoned it January 31, 1964 as follows:

1. Moved on casing pullers and attempted to pull 2-3/8" tubing. Shot off tubing at 3710 and spotted 200 sacks plug from 3710 to 4672'.
2. Filled 7" casing with heavy mud.
3. Spotted 12 sacks cement plug in 9-5/8" - 7" annulus.
4. Removed well head and spotted 5 sacks cement plug from surface to 24'.
5. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
