RE: Dual Completion State Well No. 4
San Juan County, New Mexico

Dear Sir:

This is to advise that we propose to Dually Complete our "State" Well No. 4, located 1090 ft. f/SL and 1500 ft. f/WL of Sec. 32, T-29N, R-9W, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 320 acre tract being the W/2 of Sec. 32.

We propose to complete this well in substantially the following manner:

- (A) Set 7" casing thru the Pictured Cliffs (Approx) 2400' and cement with 150 sacks. Set 4 1/2" liner (Approx) 2375' to T.D. (Approx) 4650' and cement from T.D. back into the 7" casing.
- (B) Perforate the 4 1/2" Casing in the Mesaverde Zone. Perforate the 7" Casing in the Pictured Cliffs Zone.
- (C) Set production type packer between these two zones.
- (D) Produce the Mesaverde gas thru the tubing and the Pictured Cliffs gas thru the tubing-casing annulus.
- (E) Install dual string of tubing or siphon line to (Approx) 2400' to remove condensate from tubing-casing annulus



(F) That if granted permission to dually complete this well in the above manner, we will comply with all the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to Maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
