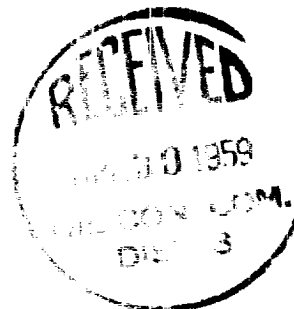

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 152.8-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

**TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, NMPM
Section 31: SE/4**

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Cain Well No. 7, located 990 feet from the South line and 1190 feet from the East line of said Section 31.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 (B), of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 152.8 acres.

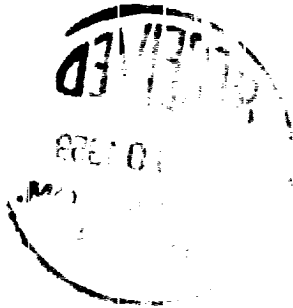
