

DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 3962 feet. Hole was filled back to 1265 feet with cement. Perforations at 1227 feet were squeezed with 150 sacks cement. Casing was cut at 800 feet with 100 feet cement cap on stub of pipe. Hole was cemented with 50 sacks cement from 265 feet to 160 feet. Marker was set in surface pipe with 10 sacks cement.
