Re: Application of Aztec Oil & Gas Company for an exception to Rule 112-A(a) for administrative approval of a gas-gas dual completion well in the Blanco-Mesa-verde Gas Pool and the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Zone.

Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 112-A, (a), as amended by Order R-824, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for an exception to Rule 112-A, (a), and for approval of a proposed Gas-Gas Dual Completion well to be located on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M. San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The proposed well is to be known as the Aztec-Koch State #1 and will be located One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty (1,980) feet from the North line and Two Thousand Four Hundred and Forty (2,440) feet from the East line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. A separate application is being filed for approval of this Non-Standard Location.

2. The well will be within the defined limits of the Blanco-Mesa-verde Gas Pool and the recognized producing zone of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs zone. The proposed gas-gas dual completion will use a single string of tubing with a side door choke, a bleeder string in the annular space, and an acceptable separation packer.

3. So far as is known to applicant, the following Operators own mineral rights offsetting the proposed well.

- (a) El Paso Natural Gas Company
- (b) El Dorado Refining Company
- (c) Sue Turner
- (d) Sam Dazzio


