We propose to convert this well to inject water into the Gallup Sand Reservoir through perforations 3,525-3,515' in accordance with our 1965 plan of development. This plan was submitted 1-25-65 and approved by the Acting Regional Oil & Gas Supervisor on 2-25-65. A packer will be set at approximately 3,425' 300' below the calculated top of cement at 4,500', and water injected through the tubing. Initial injection rate will be approximately 1,000 MGD. Current daily average production for the well is 11 M and 117 BW.

The proposed work will include pulling rods and tubing, changing out to 2 1/2 inch tubing, and shooting the tubing with a packer. The proposed conversion will begin about April 25, 1966.
