2. Drilled to T.B. of 265' R.K.B. Ran 7 jts. 8-5/8" O.D., 24.00#, J-55 casing. Landed at 250.75 P.K.B. cemented with 175 sacks regular w/2% C.C.
3. Cement circulated. Run down 12:5 P.M. 10-17-62.
4. Pressured up on surface casing to 90 psi. for 15 minutes, pressure held 1:10 P.M. 10-18-62.
5. Drilling ahead with 7-7/8" hole.
