Reference is made to your letter dated January 18, 1960 regarding administrative approval to dually complete State of New Mexico Gas Unit "D" Well No. 1, SW/4 SE/4 of Section 32, T-29-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Attached is the open flow potential test on the Fruitland formation at a rate of 2,513 MCF per day with only a trace of water. As shown in the Diagramatic Sketch of Dual Completion attached to our Application for Dual Completion, a Garret Sleeve is located in the tubing string below the Fruitland perforations. This sleeve can be opened and a plug placed in the Otis Type "S" nipple so that the Fruitland could be swabbed off in the event that water should log off the well.

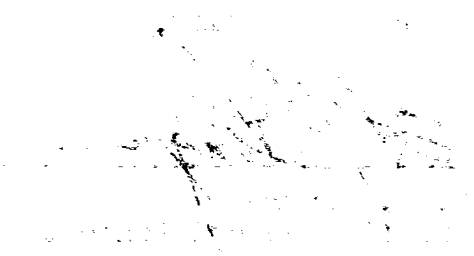
