Gentlemen:

Pubco Petroleum Corporation, as Operator of the Pubco State No. 25
Well, hereby submits Application for Approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit,
comprising the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range
11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the follow-
ing:

1. That the Pubco State No. 25 Well is located 1090 feet
from the South line and 1290 feet from the West line
of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, San
Juan County, New Mexico.
2. That the non-standard gas proration unit as proposed con-
sists of 157.24 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter
sections and lots and which comprise the Southwest Quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 11 West,
San Juan County, New Mexico.
3. That the unorthodox size of the tract is due to a variation
in legal subdivision of the U. S. Public Land Surveys.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies
wholly within a single governmental section.
5. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may
reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

2. The Board of Directors of the Corporation has also approved the following resolution:

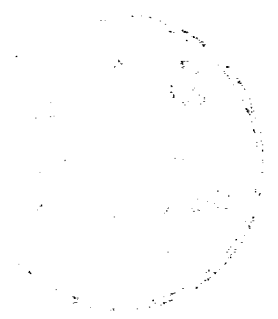

Therefore, Pubco Petroleum Corporation requests that under the provision of Rule 6(B) of Order No. R-565-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6(A) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.

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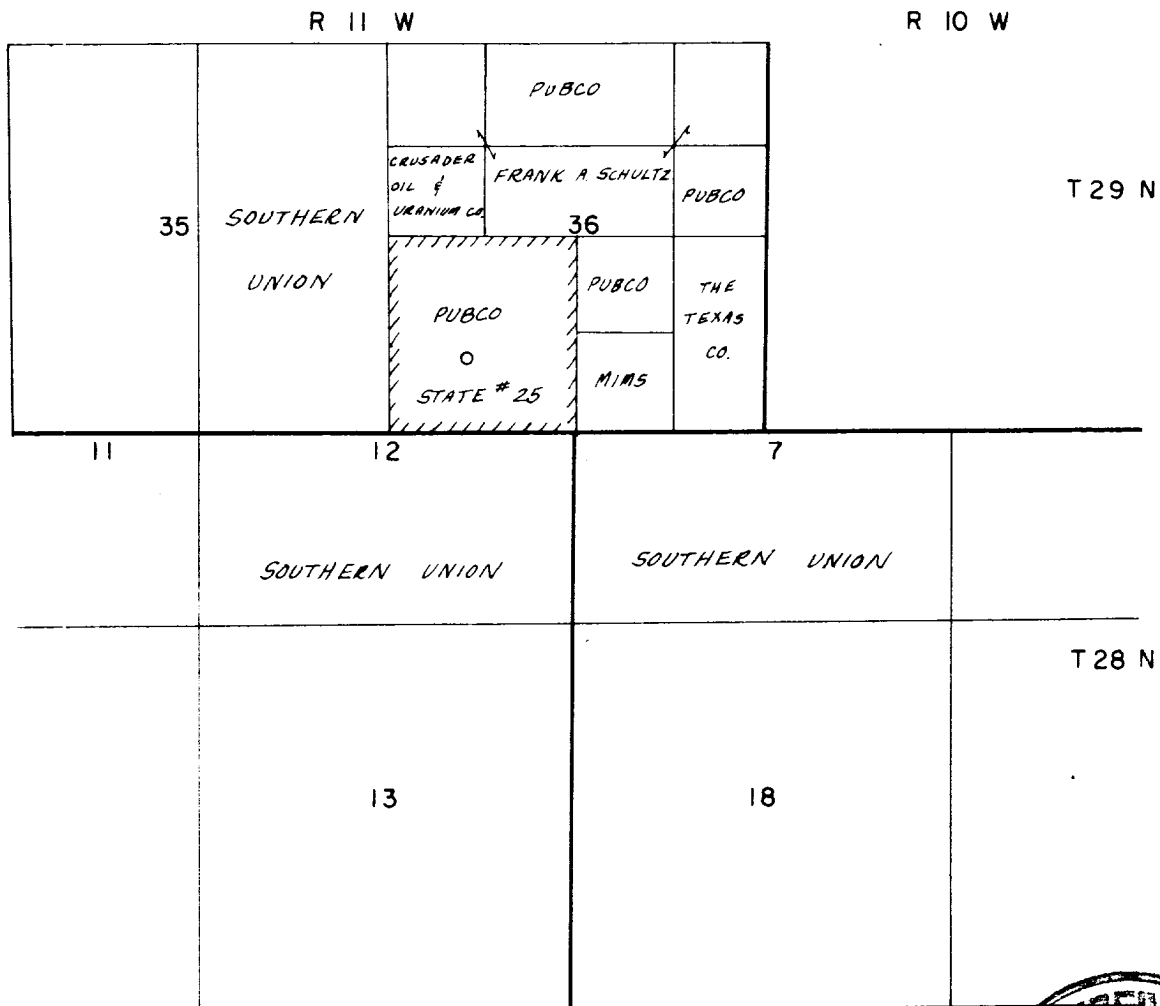
