1. Rigged up Rotary Tools. Spud $12\frac{1}{4}$ " hole at 11:00 P.M. 5/27/61.
2. Drilled $12\frac{1}{4}$ " hole to T.D. of 237 ft.
3. Ran 7 jts. 8-5/8" OD. 32.00#, J-55 Surface Casing.
4. Landed surface casing at 229.45 R.K.B. and cemented with 150 sacks regular cement w/2% calcium chloride.
5. Plug down at 9:15 A.M. 5/28/61. W.O.C.
6. Nippled up Pressure test csg., at 800 PSI. for 30 minutes. Pressure held. 5/29/61.
7. Presently drilling ahead.
