Keys Gas Unit "B" Well No. 1—on December 18, 1957, 5-1/2" casing was set at 1905' with 450 sacks of 6% gel cement, and followed by 50 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement for 17 days, 5-1/2" casing was tested with 2500 pounds (special test) which held with no drop in pressure.
