Recovered 1530' of Gas, 20' of gas cut mud, 90' of Gas cut mud W/trace oil, & 90' of extremely heavy gas cut mud est. 3% Oil. IHP-3470#, FHP-3440#, ITP-60#, FFP-90#, 1/2 Hr. HHP-616#, 1 Hr. HHP-2217#, and 1 1/2 Hr. HHP-3176#.
