According to a telephone conversation with Mr. Bill Perdue of Aztec O & G, the situation is as follows:

All oil produced from the Hagood "G" #29 well is seperated, tanked, and run from the location. Such location is in the Cha Cha-Gallup Pool. All seperator gas is conducted through the flowling to the Hagood "G" #28 where it is commingled with oil and gas from that well. The commingled product is then flowed to the Hagood "G" Battery "F" in the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool. No gas is to be vented or flared.
