RE: Application to Dually Complete  
"Florence" Well No. 26, San Juan  
County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (A) That Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation "Florence" Well No. 26 is located 990 ft. f/BL and 990 ft. f/WL of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 9 East, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 340 acre tract being the W/2 of Section 25. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well and the drilling unit together with the location of all offset wells and operators.
- (B) That the subject well has 9 5/8" casing set at 2512 ft. and cemented with 770 sacks of cement. Also 7" casing from 2475 ft. to 4757 ft. cemented with 390 sacks of cement.
- (C) That the applicant dually completed the well in the following manner:
  - (1) Perforated the 7" casing in the intervals from 4626 ft. to 4700 ft. and 4076 ft. to 4112 ft. and 4030 ft. to 4064 ft. in the Mesaverde Zone.
  - (2) Perforated the 9 5/8" casing in the intervals from 2374 ft. to 2466 ft. in the Pictured Cliffs Zone.
  - (3) Set production type packer between these two zones at 2523 ft. to separate the Pictured Cliffs and the Mesaverde Zones.
  - (4) Produced the Mesaverde gas through the tubing and the Pictured Cliffs gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The attached Exhibit B is a diagrammatic sketch of the dual completion.



- (D) That the granting of this application to produce this well as a dual completion with gas from the Mesaverte and gas from the Pictured Cliffs is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
- (E) That the applicant will comply with all the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (F) That the manner and method of this dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (G) That by copy of this letter of application by registered mail all offset operators are notified of this dual completion.

Therefore, Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to produce the subject well as a dual completion as proposed in this application.

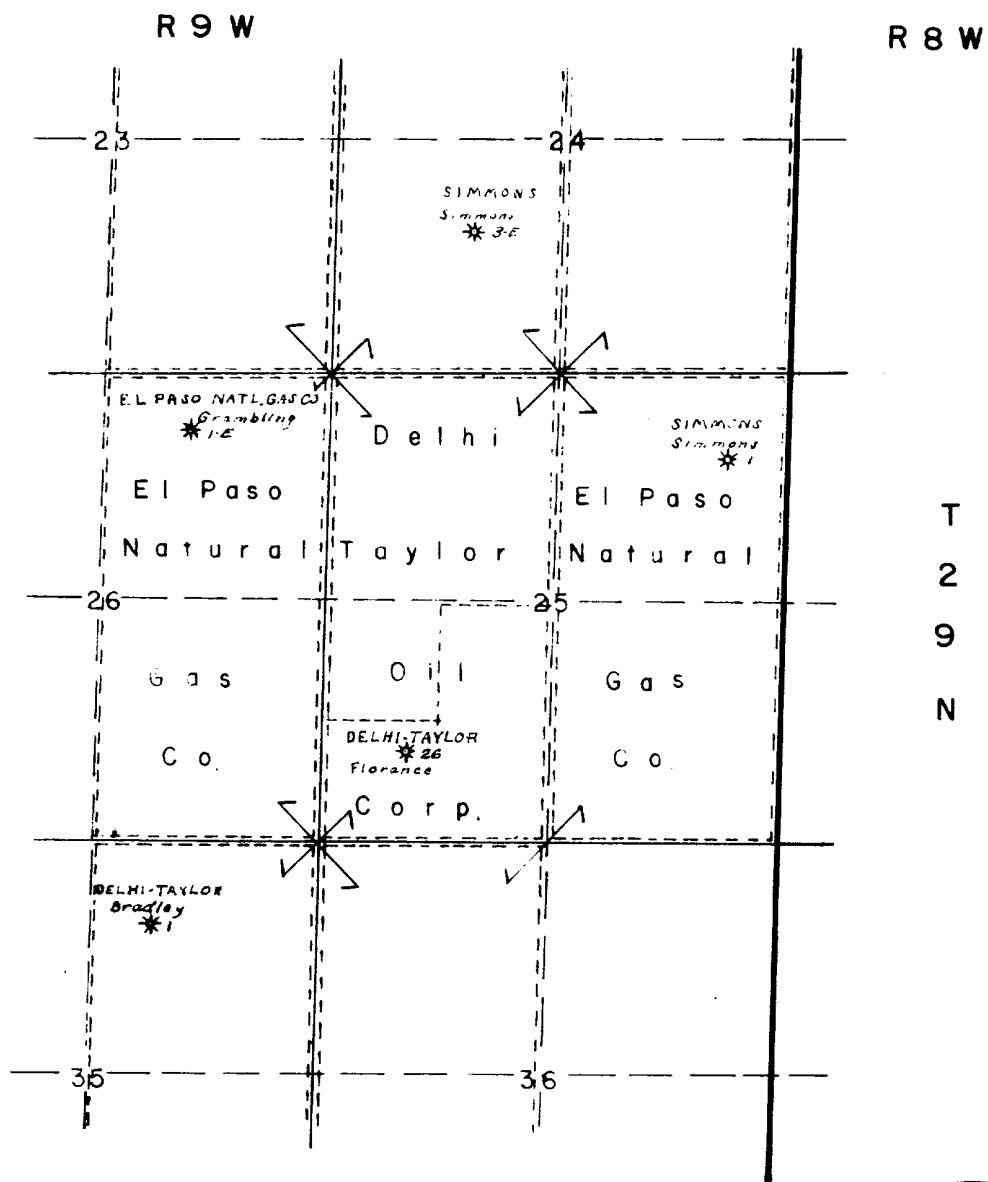
