- (A) That Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation "Florence" Well No. 26 is located 990 ft. f/BL and 990 ft. f/WL of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 340 acre tract being the W/2 of Section 25. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well and the drilling unit together with the location of all offset wells and operators.
- (B) What the subject mell has 9 5/8" casing set at 2512 it. and communical with 770 eachs of communical Also 7" casing from 2475 ft. to 4757 ft. camented with 390 sacks of coment.
- (C) That the applicant dually completed the well in the following
  - (1) Perforated the 7° ensing in the intervals from 1626 ft. to 1700 ft. and 1076 ft. to 1112 ft. and 1030 ft. to 1066 ft. in the Meseverde Zone.
  - (2) Perforated the 9 5/8" easing in the intervals from 237% ft. to 2466 ft. in the Pictured Cliffs Jone.
  - (3) Set production type packer between times two somes at 2523 ft. to separate the Platured Cliffs and the Messverde James.

(4) Produced the Mesaverde gas through the tubing and the Pictured Cliffs gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The stracked Exhibit B is a diagrammatic shotch of the dual completion.


