On September 27, 1956, this well was perforated from 1830 to 1850 feet with four shots per foot. The well was then sand-water fracked with 20,000 gallons water and 30,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 3300 pounds, average treating pressure 1300 pounds, average injection rate 50 barrels per minute. Preliminary test after frac, 456 MCF per day.
