DETAILS OF WORK

The well was cased on 3/13/56 and on 3/15/56, 9-5/8" casing was set at 211 feet and cemented with 170 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

On 3/27/56, 5" casing was set at 1970 feet and cemented with 75 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for five days, casing and water shut-off were tested with bailer test for seven hours. Casing tested all right. Completion operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
