Subject well is within the horizontal limits of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool. Therefore the casing must be cemented through the Pictured Cliffs Formation.

The CIO plate of 1981 and 1952 surveys indicate the acreage for the South half of subject section to be 268.42 acres. A non-standard unit of that size was proposed in Case No. 2327. The subsequent order should be issued in the near future.
