ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Paul Case made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 16, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Sullivan Well No. 5, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now on this 8th day of March, 1959, the Secretary-Director reads:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been received from the operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the well-spacing period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause damage to or impairment of correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Paul Case, be and the same be hereby authorized to dually complete its Sullivan Well No. 5, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section 7 of Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1314.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take back-surface acreage upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Well-spacing Period for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may be necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any of the

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of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may re- terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-well production in the interest of conservation.
