Your dual application is herewith returned so that you may provide the following necessary information.

- (1) Location of subject well on plat.
- (2) Control equipment on 2" tubing or packer for blank off plug, PSI tool, side door choke, sleeve or other possible necessary equipment for controlling possible commingling of zones if upper zone must be worked through tubing (i.e. in cases where upper zone might log off with water, etc.).
- (3) If pin collar is to be inserted in tubing above packer should lower zone have to be swabbed.

If you will complete the information required on dual applications in the future, it will help the Commission to process your forms without delay.
