

**THE APPLICATION OF PAUL GASE
FOR PERMISSION TO REQUEST DUAL
COMPLETION OF ITS SULLIVAN WELL
NO. 4, LOCATED IN THE NW 1/4 SW 1/4
OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH,
RANGE 11 WEST, NMHM, SAN JUAN COUNTY,
NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO
PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM
THE PICTURED CLIFFS FORMATION
ADJACENT TO THE FULCHER KUTZ-
PICTURED CLIFFS POOL AND THE
PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE AZTEC
FRUITLAND FORMATION.**

ORDER NO. P-11

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A (1) Paul Gase made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 6, 1958, for permission to dual complete its Sullivan Well No. 4, located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMHM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Aztec Fruitland Pool.

Now, on the 28th day of November, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:


- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of § 3, Section 11-C of Rule 11-A of the Commissioner's Rules and Regs.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all rights of other oil leaseholders have been duly notified, and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the 30-day period as prescribed in Rule 11-A.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor interfere with correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED;

That the applicant herein, Paul Gase, be and he is hereby granted to dual complete its Sullivan Well No. 4, located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMHM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Aztec Fruitland Pool, through the tubing and the casing respectively.

FURTHER ORDERED, that applicant shall make a report of the production and decline in accordance with the provisions of Section 11-B, Rule 11-A, as amended by Rule 4.

FURTHER ORDERED, that applicant shall take back or seek a new completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Decade Audit Test Period for the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that jurisdiction of this cause is to be retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may be necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commissioner may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors & assigns to limit its entitlement to regular single-zone production at the rate of oil conservation.
