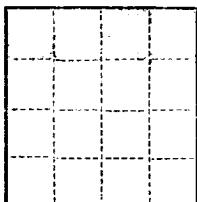

DETAILS OF WORK

On May 2, 1956, this well was perforated with two jet shots per foot from 1250 to 1270 feet.

On May 3, 1956, this well was sand-water fracked through the above perforations with 20,000 gallons water and 30,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 2600 pounds pressure. Treating pressure was 1100 pounds and average injection rate 44 barrels per minute. Preliminary test 2684 MCF per day.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
