


Attached is Form C-104, Request for Gas Allowable, covering Florance No. 27 in the Blanco Mesaverde field. This well was recently repaired by cementing the old shot hole, re-drilling to 4510, running 4-1/2" casing from surface to T.D., perforating and sand fracing the Mesaverde section.

The repair was completed November 10, 1964, and was reconnected November 25, 1964, by Southern Union Gathering Company for the first day of conditioning period for the new deliverability test.
