- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112 Age as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V. Rule 112-A. as amended by Order & 1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer leakage tests
