DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 10, 1956, this well was perforated as follows: from 1920' to 1902' with two shots per foot; from 1902' to 1892' with four shots per foot; from 1892' to 1884' with two shots per foot.

Well was then fraced with 20,000 gallons water and 30,000 pounds sand. Formation broke at 2500 pounds, treating pressure 1250 to 1350 pounds, injection rate was 43.7 BPM. Preliminary test after frac 2100 MGFPD.
