**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your letter dated May 31, 1968, wherein you request authority to complete your Davis Gas Com "F" Well No. 1, located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, as a tubingless completion to produce gas from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool through a full string of 2 7/8-inch casing which is to be run inside the existing 4 1/2-inch casing and cemented from the Baker Model P Packer set at 6022 feet to the surface. It is our understanding that this tubingless completion is to be utilized in an existing well as a means of casing repair and will be similar in all respects to the previously-approved casing repair method utilized in several other wells in the area which developed leaks.

Pan American Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to complete the aforesaid well in the above-described manner as a tubingless completion.
