Tool open 4 Hours; Had blow of air immediately & continued throughout test, (Gas to surface in 1 1/2 Hr.,) gas volume too small to measure. Closed tool for BHP. Recovered 120' Gas Out Mud and 30' of very heavy gas cut mud and trace of oil also, trace of fresh water, (No briny taste in water).
