- Run 4 joints, 9-5/8", 11.40, 32.30', surface casing on January 11, 1959. Casing landed at 130 ft. B.L.B. Cemented with 85 sacks regular cement with 25 calcium chloride. Cement circulated to surface.
- Drilled plug and pressured up on surface casing to 500 psi for 30 minutes, on January 12, 1959, pressure held.
