Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, manager and operator for Unicon Producing Company, filed for a temporary pressure buildup petition for the months of January, February and March, 1985 and the reason for the shut in status for the well was termed "drill gas" for January, 1985.

In checking with our district office in Farmington, I found that the well was disconnected from the meter and the production from that well was used by Southland Royalty as a drilling fluid to drill another well on the lease. The actual production was not measured, however, we could probably estimate the production if this was needed.
