ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2154, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on June 13, 1963, for permission to expand its Cha Cha-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Cha Cha-Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 23rd day of September, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2154.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2154.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of Pressure Maintenance to wit:

Northwest Cha Cha Unit Well No. 32-25 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 25 and Northwest Cha Cha Unit Well No. 32-36 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 36, both in Township 29 North, Range 14 West, NMPM.
