The above well was spudded on April 2, 1963 and drilled to 371'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 368' with 200 sacks neat cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement was circulated to surface. After waiting on cement, casing was tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. Test ok. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 371' and resumed drilling.
