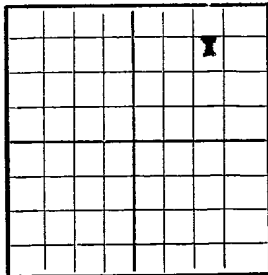

Additional information: We propose to drill a well with rotary tools to test the Farmington sandstone. If production is indicated we will set 5 1/2" casing through the sandstone and perforate the casing.

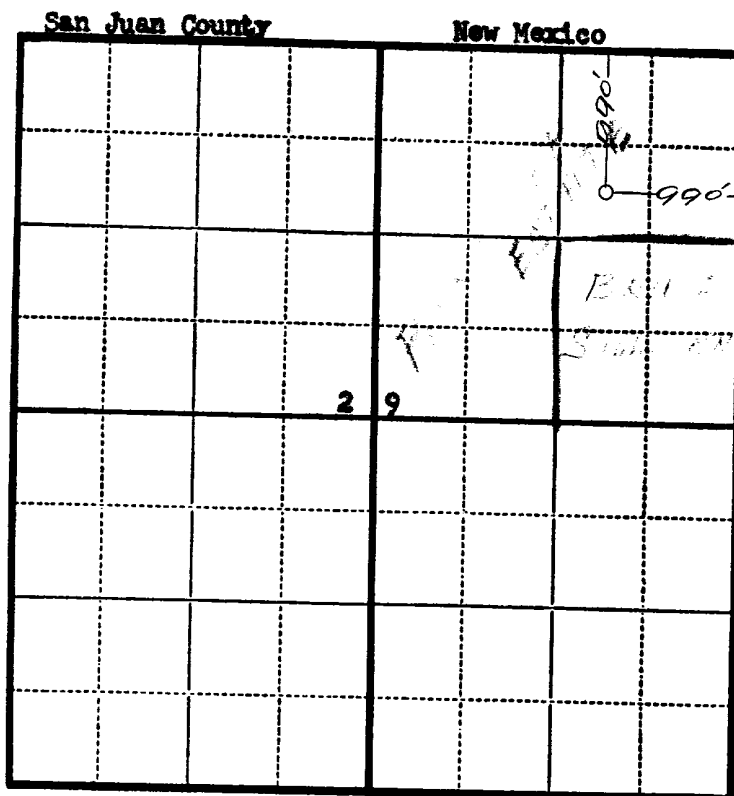
