#### PXA Procedures GCU 154

- 1. Check location for anchors. Install if necessary. Test anchors.
- 2. MIRUSU. Blow down well. Kill if necessary with fresh water.
- 3. POOH with 2 3/8" tbg. RIH with tbg and cement retainer, set retainer at 5900'. Test casing integrity to 500#. Squeeze perfs at 5960' to 6070' with 73.297 cuft cement. Pull out of retainer and spot cement plug to 5090' with 76.970 cuft cement. Fill hole with mudd to 2970'.
- 4. Spot 100' cement plug at 2970 across the Mesa Verde (13.425 cuft cement). Pull up hole and spot cement plug from 1485' to surface with 137.383 cuft of cement.
- 5. NDBOPE. Cut off casing and wellhead. Install PXA marker according to BLM or State requirements.
- 6. Turn over to John Schwartz for reclamation.
- 7. Rehabilitate location according to BLM or State requirements.
